Notes from the Board Meeting

Time and Location: The February 23, 2011, School Board Meeting was held in the Administrative Office Board Room beginning at 7:00 PM.

Superintendent's Report: Superintendent Parsons reported that the Douglas ESD has formally accepted the oversight responsibility for the educational component of the Juvenile Detention Center, beginning with the 2011-12 school year. He announced that Roseburg High School athletes excel in their



sport and academically. The girls swim team is ranked 10th in the state 6A division with a collective GPA of 3.67; boys basketball is ranked 3rd in the state 6A division with a collective GPA of 3.49; and the wrestling team is 1st in the state 6A division with a collective GPA of 3.56. He reminded school board members that the deadline to file for school board election is March 17, 2011, and thanked those Board members who have already filed for their positions. The Fremont Middle School Jazz Band will be conducting a fund raising dinner at Jasmine's Catering and Event Center on March 4, with proceeds going to help support their trip to the Reno Jazz Festival.

Recognitions: At each board meeting the School Board awards Certificates of Accomplishments to students of the month in the Roseburg School District. Students receiving awards were: Colleen Jackson/Rose, Madison Malek/Green and David Rodriguez/Jo Lane.

The Board honored Kris Kelso, Instructional Coach at Winchester Elementary, with the "Crystal Apple Award." This award is presented to educators for having gone above and beyond the call of duty, making a significant contribution to the school and education of students.

Personnel Transactions: The Board approved the recommendation to employ Lindsey O'Reiley, Language Arts teacher at RHS.

Action Items: The Board took action to adopt Resolution 10-11-16: Classified Employee Week, which is March 7-11. The Board also took action to repeal Policy CCF: Physical Examinations of Administrators.

RHS Student Representative Report: Haley Van Volkenburg, RHS Student Representative, reported that the boys basketball team will participate in their first playoff game on March 1, at Roseburg High School. Girls basketball will participate in their playoff game on February 25, in Redmond. The girls swim team took 8th and the boys took 13th in state competition. The wrestling team will be taking 14 participants to state competition in Portland this weekend. February 21-25, is Literacy Week and the high school is celebrating with various activities throughout the week focused on reading and literacy. The drama class will be performing "The Music Man" on February 24, 25 and 26, in the Rose Theatre beginning at 7:00 PM, and the Nocturnal Revolutions "Blackout Dance" will be held on March 5.

Board Committee Reports: The Administration and Personnel Committee met on Tuesday, February 22, 2011, to discuss the renewal process for the Administrative Conditions of Employment. They also heard a report regarding probationary staff reviews, discussed statute regarding administrative contracts, and reviewed the school board's responsibility with relation to student expulsion order appeals.
