## Notes from the Board Meeting

Time and Location: The April 14, 2010, School Board Meeting was held in the Administrative Office Board Room beginning at 7:00 PM.

Superintendent's Report:: Superintendent Parsons reminded school board members that the



annual OSBA Spring Regional Dinner will take place on Thursday, April 22, beginning at 6:00 PM in the UCC Timber Room. The Day of Caring is a city-wide event sponsored by the United Way where individuals from local businesses and organizations volunteer at local nonprofit organizations and public

schools. This event will take place in Roseburg on Saturday, May 22, 2010. Thanks to Project Leadership and Victory Builders, Fir Grove Elementary School recently received a new sign in front of the campus and will soon have some silhouettes of children in action attached to the fencing around the perimeter of the school. The annual Truth, Lies, and Videotapes event took place at Umpqua Community College on April 9. Dr. Parsons commended Mary McClintock, RHS Media Specialist, for her work with students on this project and the Roseburg students for their participation in this annual event. The Rock Ed Outdoor Education Center project will have their ground breaking ceremony on Thursday, April 22, at 11:00 AM at the Rock Creek Fish Hatchery. Students in the RHS Vo Tech Cad Drawing class participated in the design of this outdoor education center. The Jo Lane Middle School Student Council recently received an award from the County Commissioners for conducting a trash audit of the school. Superintendent Parsons commended Doug Tovey, RHS Assistant Wrestling Coach, for being selected the 2010 National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant High School Wrestling Coach of the Year for the state of Oregon.
