Notes from the Board Meeting

Time and Location: The May 9, 2012, School Board Meeting was held in the Administrative Office Board Room beginning at 7:00 PM.

Superintendent's Report:



Superintendent Parsons reported that there is going to be a girls' soccer pancake breakfast fund raiser at Applebee's on May 19, from 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM. He shared that he has recently received positive correspondence from parents including one commending the

"Step Up Program" at RHS. He reminded the School Board that Eastwood Elementary will conduct their Nature Days activities May 21 - 25. The annual Jo Lane Middle School Musical, "You're a Good Man Charlie Brown" will be performed May 10, 11 and 12, beginning at 7:00 PM. Dr. Parsons reported that a survey is being sent home with all kindergarten through fourth grade students to determine if there is an interest in before and after school childcare. He noted that he has been working with the YMCA to evaluate families' interest in this service.

Communication to the Board:

Superintendent Parsons reported the resignations for the purpose of retirement of Jennifer Carloni, 3rd grade teacher at Melrose Elementary, Jennifer Doerner, English teacher at Roseburg High and Gary Gamble, Social Studies teacher at Roseburg High.

The Board approved the recommendation to hire Jacob Peterson, Special Education teacher at Fremont Middle School and Elizabeth Kolberg, Second Grade teacher at Hucrest Elementary.

2012-2013 student fees. The Board took action to re-adopt the 2012-2013 and adopted the 2013-2014 School Calendars as modified. The Board also adopted Resolution 11-12-17: Support for Roseburg High School Team Name. Resolution 11-12-18: Measure Election - Four Year Local Option Levy was also approved as modified.
