## Notes from the Board Meeting

**Time and Location:** The September 9, 2009, School Board Meeting Administration was held at 7:00 PM in the Administrative Office Board Room.



### **Superintendent's Report:**

Superintendent Parsons reported that the school year is off to an extraordinarily good start. He has been visiting schools and every classroom is full of teachers who are busy teaching and students who are eagerly learning.

Lance Colley reported that the Vine Street resurfacing and sidewalk installation project is taking longer than anticipated. He has been in communication with the City, and the project manager is working with the contractor to address the concerns related to traffic and pedestrian safety and access to Jo Lane Middle School

**Communications to the Board:** Superintendent Parsons reported on the resignation for the purpose of retirement of Linda Dwight, 5<sup>th</sup> grade teacher at Fullerton IV Elementary.

### **Special Presentation:**

Chair Garcia presented Lance Colley, Director of Business Operations, and his staff with a plaque for excellence in financial reporting from the Government Finance Officers Association. This award is presented to the District for its comprehensive annual financial report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008. The GFOA is awarded to governing agencies whose comprehensive annual financial reports achieve the highest standards in government accounting and financial reporting. This is the ninth consecutive year that the business office has received this high award.

**Action Items:** The Board approved the Board and Superintendent Goals for 2009 - 2011.

### **Reports and Discussions:**

Superintendent Parsons shared information on the H1N1 virus and discussed the curricular and operational concerns in the event of a school closure, as well as the logistics of providing
