Notes from the Board Meeting

Time and Location: The February 9, 2011, School Board Meeting was held in the Administrative Office Board Room beginning at 7:00 PM.

Superintendent's Report::



Superintendent Parsons expressed condolences to the families and community of South Eugene High School for the two students who recently drowned while on a field trip to the coast. He shared information regarding ring tones that students can

download on their cell phone that cannot be heard by most adults. School board members were reminded that the filing period for school board election is February 7, through March 17, with the election on May 17, 2011. He announced that the annual RHS Booster Club Banquet is scheduled for Thursday, March 10, 2011, at the Douglas County Fairgrounds, with a silent auction at 5:30 PM followed by dinner at 6:30 PM. Dr. Parsons reported that there are several interesting bills being proposed this legislative session that could potentially have an impact on education. In conclusion he reported that the polling firm contracted by the School Board concluded their scientific telephone survey of the community regarding a potential local option levy. Of the 382 individuals surveyed approximately 45% expressed support for a local option levy. An executive summary of the survey, which will be shared with the School Board, is anticipated in the near future.
