Principal's Message

Welcome to December!

It is an exciting time for all of us at Melrose as we prepare for the holiday season and all that it means to our school family and yours. Rituals, traditions, and beliefs that are cultivated while at Melrose School are as deep as the roots of the many trees and plants that surround this beautiful campus. December is a time when special traditions new and old are celebrated and remembered.

December's schoolwide theme is Sharing and Caring. We will discuss many ways we can show this characteristic in our classrooms and across our school. You may want to find a special way to share the joy of this season with a Melrose family or a member of our community. We are hosting a sock drive in December! Please bring in a new pair of socks so we can gift those to members of our community who may need them. We will fill those socks as a school family during the final week of school in December and distribute to some local agencies.

Melrose has been focusing on Safety. Schoolwide, staff are teaching student's ways to be safe. Please ask your child what he or she has learned about Safety. In December, we will conduct our first lockdown drill. Teachers will be working with students discussing and practicing when and why we would perform a lockdown. I will also send home a letter with your student the day we conduct a lockdown so you are aware of this drill.

Conferences were fabulous. Our staff spent a great deal of time preparing to share the progress of your student with you and they take these conversations very seriously. Thank you for attending and for being partners with us EVERYDAY as we learn new and exciting things.

Thank you to everyone who has been involved in helping our school set another record. As this newsletter goes to press the final numbers are still being tabulated but I can confirm that we sold over \$50,000 dollars worth of scrip this MONTH. We had more families participate and more projects around Melrose will be completed as we work together to support the educational, social, and emotional needs of all of our students.

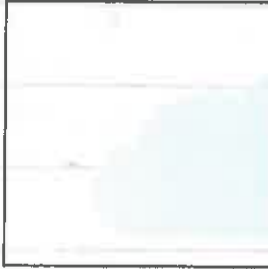
